CRITERIA FOR FUNDING

ABOUT THE GRANT SCHEME

The Scheme is being established to support Voluntary/Community Organisations seeking assistance with one-off purchases/projects to further their aims.

How much will the Council fund – 75% of the cost involved up to a maximum of £500.

Applications will be considered quarterly by the Council's Finance Committee.

WHO CAN APPLY

Any non-profit making Community/Voluntary Organisation serving all or part of the Community Council area which is:-

- Exclusively Locally Focussed
- Independent
- Self governing

TO APPLY, ORGANISATIONS WILL NEED

- A Constitution or set of rules adopted by the Organisation which must be included with the application.
- A bank or building society account with at least two joint signatures.
- Annual accounts or a statement of income and expenditure which must be included with the application.
- To provide a copy of latest bank/building society statements for all accounts held by the Organisation.

GRANTS WILL BE CONSIDERED FOR

- Equipment
- Events
- Special projects
- Feasibility studies
- 'One off' training

GRANTS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED FOR

- General running costs
- Endowments
- Loan payments
- Activities promoting specific religious or political beliefs
- Second-hand goods
- Salaries, wages, honoraria

GRANTS WILL NOT BE MADE TO

- Trading/profit-making Companies
- Statutory bodies
- Individuals or funds set up to benefit an individual.
