

From the 4th of September (**weather permitting**) we will be commencing a phased restart of Community Walks with a morning walk. At present we will not be restarting afternoon walks.

The first of these will be Hawarden. As the Hawarden Institute is still not open we will be meeting on the Institute Carpark at 9.45 for a 10am start.

During this new normal the following will apply:

1. Initial walks are limited to 12 people on a first come first served basis
2. You will be required to supply contact details (**Test , Trace, Protect**) as per Welsh Gov Guidelines
3. Anyone not feeling well or with any of the following symptoms is asked not to walk (**High Fever, Continuous Cough or Loss Of taste and Smell**)
4. Please note we have no onsite toilet facilities
5. A walk register will be completed by a single Walk Leader
6. Social distancing will be maintained at all times
7. You will be asked to take away and complete a new health Questionnaire

It is our intention to make the walks as safe as possible for everyone. We look forward to seeing you.
