COUNCIL CHAIR PERSON

Councillor Phil Griffiths of The Boulevard, Broughton has been appointed as Chair of the Community Council for the Municipal Year 2008/2009. Councillor Billy Mullin has been appointed Vice-Chair.



COUNCIL'S EXPENDITURE 2008/2009

The Council's budget for 2008/2009 allows for expenditure of £161,600. To facilitate this the Council's precept is £80,000, which represents £33.91 for an average Band 'D' property, an increase of less than 1%.

WARREN HALL BUSINESS PARK

The construction of the new A55 on and off slip roads, associated with the proposed Warren Hall Business Park, is due to commence in August. It is anticipated that the slip roads will significantly reduce the volume of traffic travelling along the A5104 through Broughton.

NAMING OF COUNCIL CHAMBER

The Community Council has decided to name its Council Chamber The Edwin Hall Council Chamber in memory of the late Councillor Eddie Hall who passed away last year. Councillor Hall had been a Member of the Community Council since its formation in 1985 and had represented the Broughton North Ward on Alyn & Deeside District Council and Flintshire County Council where he served for four years as its Deputy Leader.

COMMUNITY POLICE OFFICER

The Community Council has been lobbying hard for the reinstatement of a dedicated Community Police Officer for Broughton and Bretton since the decision to remove the post was



taken last year. We are delighted therefore that the Inspector for South Flintshire has now decided to reinstate PC Phil Mather to this role with effect from 18 June 2008. PC Mather can be contacted on 07787177324.

HOUSING DEVELOPMENT OFF BEESTON ROAD, BROUGHTON

Plans have been submitted for the construction of 23 dwellings on land adjacent to the children's play area.

PEDESTRIAN CROSSING – BROUGHTON HALL ROAD

Flintshire County Council has announced that it is to construct a pedestrian crossing and vehicle activated speed signs in the vicinity of the schools on Broughton Hall Road, to improve pedestrian safety.
