FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO LOCAL ORGANISATIONS

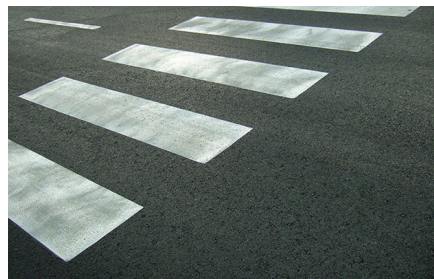
The Council has recently awarded the following grants to local organisations:
