NOTICE UNDER LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1972

(SECTION 87(2))

VACANCY FOR ONE COUNCILLOR

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN

that the vacancy has occurred in the office of Councillor for the **South** Ward of the Community of **BROUGHTON AND BRETTON** following the resignation of Councillor Louisa Rusado in November 2025.

- 1 Rule 5(2) of The Local Elections (Parishes and Communities) (England and Wales) Rules, 2006 now applies.
- 2 The rule allows **TEN ELECTORS** for the Community (Broughton South and North East) in which the casual vacancy has arisen to request the Returning Officer to hold an election to fill the vacancy. *That request must be made within **FOURTEEN DAYS**, calculated in accordance with the rules ** of the date of this notice. The fourteen-day period ends on 17th February 2026.
- 3 If no request is made the Community Council must, as soon as practicable after the expiry of the fourteen-day period, co-opt a person to fill the vacancy.

**There is no form of words for this request, which might simply be a letter headed with such words as "We the undersigned being electors for the [Ward of] Broughton South, call for an election to fill the vacancy arising from the resignation of Louisa Rusado. It is helpful if the ten signatures are accompanied by printed names and addresses.*

***In calculating the notice period, day one is the day following the date of this notice; a Saturday, Sunday, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, Good Friday or a Bank Holiday or day appointed for public thanksgiving or mourning shall be disregarded, and the period closes at midnight on the fourteenth day after the date of this notice. Rule 5(2) of The Local Elections (Parishes and Communities) (England and Wales) Rules, 2006 now applies.*
