## 250/18 BROUGHTON COUNTRY PARK RE-DEVELOPMENT:

The Clerk and Financial Officer advised that quotes from three suppliers had been sought for the refurbishment of the play equipment at Country Park, Broughton. The three plans had been placed on display at the meeting for members' consideration. The Clerk and Financial Officer provided a confidential summary table highlighting the costs of the schemes, the number of pieces of equipment and the safety surfacing proposals etc.
