She reported that she had been extremely disappointed with the safety surfacing that, in her opinion, had been a trip hazard and not left to the standard it should have been. She had made a complaint to the installation company and had requested a second opinion from ROSPA (Royal Society for the Prevention of Accidents).

**108/19 FLINTSHIRE PLAY GUIDE:**

The Clerk and Financial Officer requested approval from Members that the play areas at Brookes Avenue and Country Park be included in a Play Guide to be developed by the County Council.
